

Plug in the charging cable to fully charge the motor. The light will change from amber to green when fully charged.



# Charging

At some point your screen will flash a red light indicating that the battery is running low Al you'll need to do is pop in the magnetic charging cable. When it's charging, the indicator will glow amber, and once it's charged fully, it turns green.



It takes about six hours to fully charge your Solo. You won't need to charge it again for a year or more, under average use conditions.

## Screen settings:

Your Solo remote comes pre-programmed to drop the screen 1" below the cassette.



Need to drop the screen farther? Use  $\bigtriangledown$  to set the screen at the bottom limit.

When it's at the limit, hold  $\triangle + \nabla$  until the screen jogs up and down once.

Use  $\triangle + \bigtriangledown$  to move the screen to the right height for your space, up to 12" from the bottom of the cassette.

Hold  $\Box$  until the screen jogs again to save the new limit.

**DO NOT** set the limit below 12" from the cassette. Doing so risks damaging the screen material

If you need to reset motor settings, call SI customer support. We'll walk you through it.



At standard 1" drop, the viewing area of the screen is 4" from the top of the cassette. When you're deciding where to put Solo, keep in mind that the brackets should be mounted on at least one stud, and the brackets should be located 12-18" in from the ends of the cassette.

## Troubleshooting tips:

Vertical wrinkles on the screen surface?

First make sure your Solo is level.

If they persist, smooth the bottom of the viewing area from the center outward.



When storing or transporting your Solo, ensure that the screen is fully closed and locked in place. The screen material can be damaged if improperly closed.
